<b>Master Teacher Residency</b>	The introduced budget added \$1 million in the second year for this program. <b>Extended Year/Day</b>	Remove language "After the third consecutive year of successful participation, an eligible school's grant shall be based on a shared split of the grant between the state and participating school division's local composite index."
